- The BAME DADS project is a three-year initiative dedicated to addressing the distinctive challenges confronted by fathers in black and minority ethnic (BAME) communities.
- Centred on empowering and supporting BAME fathers in actively engaging with their children from pre-pregnancy to age 4, the project seeks to redefine societal norms and dismantle cultural stereotypes.

### Project Reach 2023

- 277 unique individuals have accessed our sessions.
- 217 unique children in the community within Hyson Green, Forrest Fields and Aspley.
- 300 fathers engaged through community outreach activities
- 30 sessions delivered throughout the 2023
- 6 awards and the House of Commons recognition
- The project's reach extends to diverse demographics, with participants from different age groups, cultural backgrounds, and socioeconomic statuses. This diversity underscores the inclusive and accessible nature.
