What is Home Talk?

- Home visiting service for 2-2 ½ year olds
- Strategies and activities to support children's language development
- Singing, book sharing, everyday routines, out and about. Tailored to each child
- Delivered by Home Talk Workers and supported by SLTs









Who is Home Talk for?

- Children with spoken language difficulties aged 2-2.6 years
- Up to 15% of Children are eligible
- For monolingual, bilingual and multilingual children
