#### Removing barriers to breastfeeding

A report commissioned by NHS Sheffield identified some of the barriers to sustained breastfeeding

It confirmed that many women feel anxious or embarrassed about breastfeeding in public places.

With a co-ordinated partnership approach - Sheffield Local Authority, including the community-based Infant Feeding Peer Support service, NHS Sheffield and other key partners have worked to remove barriers to breastfeeding
