



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


Eco-system influencing infant feeding decisions











Example: Breastfeeding Friendly Scheme

- Significant, organic growth. 80% in 1 year
- BfN own scheme v 'white label' e.g. Islington, Portsmouth, Gloucestershire
- Growth in areas where no services e.g. Bridlington
- Breastfeeding Friendly as door opener
- Need to verify basics (e.g. inclusion) and provide training to avoid 'purple washing'





Example: Drugs in Breast Milk Information

- Over 1.52 million users of factsheets last year
- Over 3,500 calls answered by pharmacists
- Treatments and misinformation as major cause of early breastfeeding cessation
- Running since 1997. Now peer reviewed and consulted by regulators e.g. MRHA
- 'Updated/concise version' for healthcare professionals?
- Learning unique and much needed service





Example: Community and regional peer support

- ●NBH UK wide, covers area where there is no local peer support service. Signposted to by DoH and Family Hubs
- Varied Groups, walks, social media, home visits, video calls, socials
- Co-creation and partnership work what needed in locality
- The most important thing we do is LISTEN
- Quality Assurance accreditation and update training/CPD, supervision
- Learning One size does not fit all.
- Staff and volunteers are our most valuable asset— train and support them






Example: Training the eco-system
